Needy Students reach the deserving. Adding to further support to the parents, BOD has waived off the increased fee amount till July 2020.

Since the school is a nonprofit organization, the sole income of the school is fees and 90% of the income has been utilized for the salary and other benefits of the employees. As stakeholders, it is our responsibility to take care our teachers, as per our commitment and the directives of the ministry. We are all going through a difficult time and we believe all the difficulties and stress are also applicable to our teachers like it is for all of us. Hence, we request the beloved parents to cooperate with the school by paying fees monthly as well as clearing the dues, if any, within all your limitations.
