SECTION-A Reading-20 Marks

Max Mueller was a distinguished German poet. Some of his poems were set to music (8 marks) by Austrian composer, Franz Schubert.

As a youth, Max Mueller took to the study of the Sanskrit language with great devotion and started learning that language. He took his Doctorate in Philosophy in 1843. In Berlin University, he did research work on Sanskrit and Philosophy under eminent scholars.

In 1846, Max Mueller went to London in England to copy and collect manuscripts in Sanskrit. He translated Rig Veda which consists of 1028 hymns addressed to different gods. As it was being printed at the London University Press, he migrated to Oxford in 1848 and spent the rest of his life there.

The first volume of Max Mueller's edition appeared in 1849, the sixth and the last volume in 1874. This printed Rig Veda caused great enthusiasm in India. Several publications on Indian religion and literature appeared in quick succession. Max Mueller became the greatest interpreter on India to the western world.

His book "India- What It Can Teach Us' has a special place among his publications. But Max Mueller never visited India!

A vegetarian diet provides a variety of proven health benefits. Vegetarians have significantly reduced rates of obesity, heart disease, hypertension, diet related cancers, constipation and gall stones. (12 marks)

Many people are semi vegetarians who have eliminated red meat, but may eat poultry or fish. Kids or families may follow a vegetarian diet for a variety of reasons. A doctor or a dietician can help to plan and monitor a healthy vegetarian diet. Parents should give their kids a variety of healthy food that provides enough calories and nutrients to enable them to grow normally.

On the contrary, non vegetarian foods are rich in protein of high value and vitamin B complex, especially B12 which is not available in plant food. Fish, especially the small varieties are a rich source of calcium.

The incidence of high BP, heart disease, obesity and high cholesterol levels is found greater in non vegetarians. Elders who suffer from these problems should reduce the intake of fleshy food in their diet. Egg white and most varieties of fish contain less fat, but are rich in protein, vitamins and minerals.

Vegetarians or non vegetarians, the decision depends on various factors such as cultural or dietary habits of the family, personal preferences, taste and averting of certain food for various health reasons. Whatever the case, a well balanced diet supplying proteins, fats, carbohydrates, vitamins and minerals should be taken.
