- > The participating school will announce the competition details, rules and regulations & dates of the selection rounds to their students in advance.
- > Registrations will be accepted only in the prescribed format which will be sent to the participating schools in due course.
- > The selection rounds are to be conducted at the school level on the dates fixed by the respective schools.
- > Selected entries should be sent to the Host School and each School can send the maximum entries for Solo and Group Events as per the following criteria:

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- > The final entries will be evaluated based on the criteria mentioned in the Handbook by a panel of Judges.
- ➤ Each criterion carries 10 points. The scores are collated and final scores are graded as A+, A, B+, B.
- > The grades represent the performance of the participants as defined below:

- > All participants will receive a Participation Certificate and the shortlisted graded entries will be awarded with a Merit Certificate as well.
- > The decisions of the Judges shall be final & binding.
- > All A+ winning entries will be streamed on the days of ISTF.
- > The Zoom/YouTube/Facebook link for the streaming of each event will be shared by the Host School two days prior to the respective event.
- > Special Performances by the CWSN Students: Each school can send entries as per the criteria mentioned above. These performances will be streamed between various events.
- > UTAR: Participating schools can send entries as per the criteria mentioned above. These performances will be streamed between various events.

DANCE EVENTS

- 1. CLASSICAL DANCE SOLO
- 2. INDIAN FOLK DANCE GROUP
- 3. CONTEMPORARY DANCE SOLO

GENERAL RULES

- > The file name for the entry should be in the format mentioned earlier and should be uploaded to the Google Drive Folder provided for the respective event.
- > The video should be clear and in landscape mode with the participant/(s) fully visible at the center of the frame.







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- > The performing area can be either indoor or outdoor with only the participant/(s) visible in the video.
- Background should be natural. Virtual background is not allowed.
- > Camera should be fixed in a position throughout the event to avoid hazy picturization.
- Sound clarity should be ensured for the song played.
- > Performance shouldn't exceed the given time.
- > Video should be in MP4 format with good audio and visual clarity.
- > The themes, costumes, choreography and make-up should be appropriate for school competitions and should respect the culture and traditions of the Sultanate of Oman.

1. CLASSICAL DANCE - SOLO

- > Duration of performance should not exceed 5 minutes.
- > Styles allowed: Bharatanatyam, Kathak, Mohiniyattam, Odissi or Kuchipudi.
- > The theme, music, costumes and make-up should comply with traditional style.
- > Usage of properties is not entertained.
- > Participants must refrain from using fire & hazardous materials during their performance.

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2. INDIAN FOLK DANCE - GROUP

- > Duration of performance should not exceed 5 minutes.
- > A group must have a maximum of 6 participants.
- > The theme, music, costume, makeup and dance should be of Indian Traditional Folk only.
- > Performing styles that come under ritual, tribal, classical and cinematic folk will not be entertained.
- > Participants are allowed to use properties which are suitable to their selected theme of dance.
- > Participants must refrain from using fire & hazardous materials during their performance.

Criteria for Awarding Grades

- Make up, Costume & Accessories
- Music
- Rhythm
- Elements of Dance Choreography
- Presentation

3. CONTEMPORARY DANCE - SOLO

- > Duration of performance should not exceed 5 minutes.
- > Style of dance and song/music should meet the following guidelines:
 - Contemporary dance should not involve classical techniques.
 - Contemporary dance may or may not be a narrative form of art.
- > Creativity and innovation would be given weightage.
- **BGM**, without lyrics, should be used.
- > Participants are allowed to use properties which are suitable to their selected theme of dance.

GENERAL RULES

- > Artwork must be original.
- > The school has to scrutinize the artwork based on the criteria given below and select their entries.
- > The entries submitted should be with full size photographs of the participants taking part in the competition. A minimum of 3 & a maximum of 5 images of the final artwork should be included in photo collage, in JPEG/JPG format.
- > A video of maximum 10 minutes duration of the process of creating the artwork should be sent along with the entry.
- > The file name for the entry should be in the format mentioned earlier and should be uploaded to the Google Drive folder provided for the respective event.







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4. GRAPHITE PENCIL DRAWING-SOLO

- Paper size (70cm X 50cm)
- ➤ Theme: India@75
- > Image drawn should fill the page.
- ➤ At least three to four values should be used (dark to light shades)
- > Participants are allowed to use any type of shading pencils/charcoal pencils to make their picture.

5. BIENNALE - GROUP

- > Theme: India@75
- Participants are allowed to use any media Art & Craft, Painting (Watercolour, Acrylic, Oil etc.).
- Material, technique, style and medium for work is open.
- > A group can have a maximum of 5 participants.

- Composition
- Creativity
- Originality
- Presentation







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6. HENNA DESIGNING-SOLO

- > Theme: Open choice of the participants
- > Henna design should be creative and unique.
- > It should be portrayed on both sides of one hand till the elbow. (Palm as well as dorsal side of the hand).
- > Participants can apply henna on their own hand or any other person's hand.
- > Henna materials and designs should be traditional in nature.

10. PATRIOTIC SONG - GROUP

- ➤ One Team One Song
- > Maximum 8 participants per group.
- > The songs selected for performance should be Indian Patriotic songs only.
- > Participants must select any song with decent lyrics from one of the Indian languages for their performance.







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- > Apart from Tampura/Shruti Box (electronic or manual), up to 2 participants each playing a single background musical instrument (any type) is allowed. This includes the maximum 8 participants.
- > Pre-programmed accompaniments will NOT be allowed.
- > Duration of the video should not exceed 5 minutes.
- > The video should display all participants on the screen.

11. CARNATIC MUSIC VOCAL - SOLO

- > Duration of performance should not exceed 7 minutes.

- A brief about the choice of the recital should be provided in the video.
- A manual or electronic Shruti box or Tampura may be used as an accompaniment.

12. WESTERN MUSIC - SOLO

- > Performance should be in Western Style.
- > Lyrics should be in English and should not be derogatory.
- Time should not exceed 4 minutes.







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- ➤ Use of karaoke music or electronic musical instruments is allowed. However, preference is given to acapella style.
- > Only the song rendition will be assessed and not the background music.

13. INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC - SOLO

- > The category includes stringed, wind, electronic and percussion.
- > Students can choose any one from the above categories.
- Maximum duration should not exceed 4 minutes.
- Film and devotional songs are not allowed.
- Pre-programmed materials are not allowed.
- The video recording should include the finger movements of the participants.

14. PATRIOTIC SONG - SOLO

- > Only Indian Patriotic songs with decent lyrics in one of the Indian languages are allowed.

- > Duration of the advertisement is 30-45 seconds.
- **Each team can consist of a maximum of 4 students.**
- ➤ Theme: India@75 with a valuable social / cultural message.
- > Originality: The work should be original. (Should not be an 'Ad' already in use in the industry)
- > Students can use video camera(s), video editing software, animation software, images etc. for the creation of their advertisement.
- > Care should be taken not to project any un-parliamentary words/unethical scenes.







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> The theme, dialogues, animations, costumes and make-up should be appropriate for school students respecting the culture & traditions of Oman.

16. DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY & ALBUM MAKING - SOLO

- > Theme: Open choice of the participants.
- > Image must be in JPEG format within 1MB to 2 MB each.(Preferred size)
- ➤ The album should contain 8-10 photographs.
- Use of Photo editing/Album-making software is allowed.
- ➤ Basic editing, including colour enhancement, the use of filters, and cropping of the Photo(s) are acceptable, provided any such editing does not affect the authenticity and/or genuineness of the Photo(s).
- > Photos should NOT be downloaded from the internet. If found, the entry will be disqualified.
- > All photographs should be geotagged.

- ➤ Theme: India@75
- Only positive social themes can be presented.
 Religious/political/controversial themes are strictly prohibited.
- > The theme, costumes, dialogues and make-up should be appropriate for the school level respecting the culture and traditions of the Sultanate of Oman.
- > The introduction should comprise title and theme.
- > Appropriate backdrops, props and costumes are recommended.

- Execution of Theme and Appropriate Climax
- Dramatic Skills
- Direction
- Social Message Conveyed
- Coordination & Overall Impact







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19. FANCY DRESS - SOLO

- ➤ Each participant will be given 90 seconds for his/her presentation.
- > The participant can deliver a short narration of his/her character.
- > Face should not be covered.
- > Participants should not be assisted by elders.
- No static postures are allowed.
- > Dance performances of any kind will not be accepted.
- > Religious characters should be avoided.
