SCHOOL REOPENING CIRCULAR (CLASSES I & II)

Dear Parent,

Greetings from ISD!

We are extremely delighted to welcome you all to yet another exciting and challenging phase of the academic session.

We are pleased to apprise you that as per the directives and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Education, it has been decided to reopen the school for the Primary Section in a phased manner. The school is going to commence the on-campus classes for the students of Classes I and II in a hybrid mode (online and physical classes) from Wednesday, 24th November 2021 until further intimations and guidelines from the MoE.

The following will be the timings for the classes:

On-campus:	8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.
Online :	11:30 a.m. to 2:10 p.m.

The existing timetable will be followed for both on-campus and online classes. Students will be divided batch wise in order to meet the guidelines issued by MoE. The other details and batch schedule will be intimated by the class teachers soon.

In light of the seriousness of COVID-19 Pandemic, the school would like to seek cooperation of the parents to follow the below listed guidelines:

General Instructions:

- Parents and students will have to strictly follow all Covid Protocols laid down in the Standard Operating Procedure issued by the Ministry of Health in this regard while dropping and picking up the child from the school.
- Please note that the school will not provide any transport facility as of now.
- Students with symptoms of Flu (fever, cold, cough etc.) must refrain from coming to school and the parent should inform the Class Teacher of their absence.
- Students must maintain proper social distancing at all times and refrain from visiting other classrooms, other than what is allotted to them.
- If students feel the symptoms of fever or flu while at school, the class teachers will guide the child to the infirmary and parents must collect them, after receiving the call from the school. Till the parent arrives, the child will be made to sit in the Quarantine room.

Daily Preparation for School:

Uniform: Children are expected to wear school uniform. However, due to short notice it will not be insisted till the school reopens after winter break.

- Girls with long hair must tie their hair in two plaits.
- Boys should have only decent and short hair. Fancy haircuts and spikes are not allowed.
- Gold or fancy chains, long earrings, necklaces, anklets, coloured hair bands and fancy watches are not allowed.
- Boys must wear belts which are black in colour with normal sized buckles.
- Please send the books as per the timetable and instructions from the teacher.

Stationery Requirements:

- Please send 3 sharpened pencils, 1 eraser, 1 ruler, 1 sharpener, 1 glue stick and a set of colour pencils every day in the pouch. Kindly write the name of the child on his/her belongings.
- Please send daily a snack-box, water bottle and napkin with your child. (duly labelled)
- The school bag should be of appropriate size and please do not send very big or too small bags for your ward. Kindly avoid sending trolley bags or any extra items in the bag.
- The regular working hours for Classes I & II are from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.
- If you need to collect your child during the school hours, please report to the office first and fill in the release form kept with the receptionist. The child will be handed over to you at the fover by a staff after due approval.
- Teach your child to say his/her father's name, driver's name and their contact number.
- Kindly note that all circulars will be uploaded in the School website for parents.

Arrival & Dispersal:

- The students must be punctual to school.
- Ensure that your child reaches school latest by 7:45 a.m. and not before 7:15 a.m. Please note that your ward should be picked up from the school latest by 10:45 a.m. by the parent or the entrusted/authorized driver. In case your child has to be picked up by an elder sibling or another adult, please handover an authorization letter for child's drop and pick up (if managed by any person other than the parent) to the Class teacher.
- All students are expected to report to the teachers in their allotted classrooms. The assisting staff will be available at the foyer to guide the students.
- Wearing of mask is mandatory at all times inside the school campus and while travelling.
- Dispersal will be staggered. Students and parents are strictly not allowed to stand in groups either inside or outside the school campus.
- Students staying in the neighborhood and in a walkable distance should go home immediately after the classes and should not wait outside the school.

Break time:

- Students are expected to have proper breakfast before coming to school and carry their own water bottles and snacks.
- Sharing of water bottles and tiffin is strictly prohibited.

Personal hygiene:

- Surgical Mask must be worn properly to cover the mouth and nose.
- Students must carry extra masks.
- All students must maintain a distance of 1 meters between themselves and teachers across the school premises.
