### Circular (KG to Class V) Road Safety Guidelines for Students and Parents

**Dear Parents** 

Greetings of the day!

To ensure the safe arrival and dispersal of all students, we aim to raise awareness among students and parents about responsible behavior in and around the school premises. It is therefore requested to adhere to the following road safety guidelines and work together to protect our children from unnecessary risks.

### 1. Crossing the Road Safely

- Look Both Ways Before Crossing: Always check for vehicles by looking left, right, and then left again before stepping onto the road.
- No Running: Walk briskly and carefully when crossing the road. Running increases, the risk of accidents.
- Wait for Traffic to Stop: Ensure that all vehicles have come to a complete stop before crossing, especially during busy times like arrival and dispersal.

### 2. Safe Entry and Exit from the School Premises

- All students are required to enter and exit through the main gate, which is monitored by staff to ensure their safety.
- Please avoid walking in vehicle areas; instead, use the sidewalks or footpaths to prevent accidents.
- It is important to follow the instructions provided by teachers and support staff during arrival and dispersal. They are present to ensure your safety.

### 3. Traffic Rules for Parents:

- Parents must adhere to the entry and exit at the school parking area to avoid creating hazards for students.
- Always drive slowly, especially near the school. The safety of children is paramount.
- Parents are requested to follow traffic guidelines and refrain from turning their vehicles within a 100-meter radius of the school gate to help prevent traffic congestion.
- We encourage parents to drop off their children near the gate, where school staff will be available to escort the students onto the school premises.
- Kindergarten parents are allowed to drop off their children at the front steps, where the national staff on duty will assist the children as they proceed to their classrooms.

### 4. School Monitored Safe Transport System

- School Monitored Safe Transport buses are to enter the school premises through the front side gate, this system is in place to reduce congestion at the main gate.
- Students using school transport must wait for the bus to stop completely before boarding or alighting. Always cross in front of the bus where the driver can see you.

### 5. General Traffic Safety Rules

- When crossing the road, avoid using mobile phones, listening to music, or any other distractions that could prevent you from noticing oncoming vehicles.
- Familiarize yourself with the traffic signals, pedestrian lights/signs and follow them diligently.

### 6. Parental Responsibility

- Ensure your child understands these safety rules and follows them diligently.
- As parents, please follow all traffic rules and guidelines around the school. Your behaviour sets an example for your children and other drivers.
- Avoid double parking or blocking entrances and exits, as it obstructs traffic flow and creates unsafe conditions.
- Parents are encouraged to remind their children not to leave the school premises without the supervision of an adult at any time.
- Please be advised that primary school begins at 7:45 AM and ends at 12:45 PM, and teachers are available starting at 7:10 AM. Therefore, parents are requested to drop off their children no earlier than 7:15 AM and to pick them up by 1:25 PM at the latest to avoid any inconvenience.

### KG Dispersal:

• Parents will be permitted to enter the foyer starting at 12:15 PM, as classes are in session prior to this time. Early arrivals can disrupt ongoing classes for grades I-V.

### **Gate Timings:**

• To ensure the safety of our students, the back gate will be locked at 7:45 AM, and the front gate will close at 7:50 AM. We kindly request that parents drop off their children on time to instill the value of punctuality and to avoid the inconvenience of your ward, standing in the latecomers' line in the foyer.
