Today we use cell phones. Instead of wires, they use signals that travel through the air. Many people don't even have a land line anymore, because they can just use a cell phone. Today's phones can connect people easily, download music from the internet and many other fascinating changes. The telephone is still changing, so nobody knows what will be possible to us in the future.
