As a youngster, Disney would often sell drawings to neighbours to make extra money. Disney's family soon moved to Kansas City, Missouri. There, he took up the job of a newspaper boy, distributing newspapers along a particular route. Disney had to help his father as they did not have a lot of money. It was not an easy job but it taught him discipline. Around his time, he also took lessons in cartooning. His family went back to Chicago in 1917.

Disney's first animated serial was called Laugh-O-grams. Their most famous character, Mickey Mouse, was created in 1927. It was about this time that sound was added to movies. With the addition of sound to animated cartoons, Mickey Mouse shot to fame. During the next five years, Walt Disney Studios completed other full-length animated classics such as Pinocchio, Fantasia, Dumbo and Bambi.
